Selection of papers will be made completely on the basis of the topic specified above and quality of work. If it is seen that the paper so received was published earlier in the CRI's bulletin that should not be selected again. In this regard the decision of the Editorial Board is final.

The manuscript should be typed in MS Word 97 or higher version; in Calibri font with font size 12; figures and pictures having more than 300 dpi for better clarity. Abstract of the paper should be of approximately 150-200 to be sent with the manuscript.

The title of the paper, author's name and affiliation, mailing address, email ID, contact phone number should appear on the first page of the article for future communication. Footnote text should be placed as endnotes. Tables along with their captions and diagrams should be placed at the right place within the text. References should be listed at the end of the article and arranged alphabetically according to the surnames of the authors and in chronological order.

The following styles should be maintained as 'References' for articles published in journals and edited volumes and for books /edited books respectively.
