Dear Sir/ Madam,

As you may kindly be aware, Ministry of Social Justice Empowerment, Department of Social Justice & Empowerment is implementing an umbrella scheme namely PM Young Achievers' Scholarship Award Scheme for a vibrant India (PM-YASASVI) for the welfare of OBC, EBC and DNT students. One of the component of this scheme is Top Class School Education for OBC and other students.

- 2. In the above scheme Government will be providing Scholarship of Rs.75,000/p.a for Class 9 and 10 and Rs.1,25,000 p.a. for Class 11 and 12 covering the School fee, hostel fee, etc. to the selected students. Selection process will be by merit in the YASASVI Entrance Test conducted by National Testing Agency on 11.09.2022. During the year 2022-23 and the target is to provide assistance to 15,000 students. I am also enclosing the number of slots allotted for each of the State. Scheme guidelines are available on the website of the Ministry i.e. https://socialjustice.gov.in schemes.
- 3. Application for registration of the Test are open from 27.07.2022 to 26.08.2022 through the web portal *https://yet.nta.ac.in.* A copy of the same is attached for your ready reference.

- Date of the exam: 11.09.2022 (Sunday)
- Documents for application: Student should have a valid functional Mobile Number, Aadhar Number (UID), Aadhar linked Bank Account, Income Certificate and Caste Certificate.
