I am directed to request you to kindly instruct all the P.O. cum DWOs of all the districts of this State to obtain prior approval of the Collector of the concerned district relating to the implementation of Section 14C of the West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955 (matters of transfer of Tribal Land to Non-Tribals).
